Bob Coyle is the Vice President of Government Affairs for Republic Services of Southern Nevada. Bob is responsible for the franchise agreements for waste collection and recycling services for 520,000 homes and more than 21,000 businesses in Las Vegas, North Las Vegas, Henderson and Clark County. Republic Services operates more than 240 residential collection routes, 100 commercial collection routes and 100 industrial collection routes in Clark County, NV.

Coyle began his career in the waste industry in 1969 with Waste Management, Inc. Since then, Coyle has worked in the solid waste management industry in California, Illinois, Hawaii and Europe. Coyle's experience also includes the solid waste planning and collection for the Los Angeles Olympic Games in 1984, which was the equivalent of coordinating the waste collection service for a city of 50,000 people with a start up and shut down in just six weeks.

Immediately prior to joining Republic Services, Coyle was with Waste Management, Inc. in Orange County, CA where he was responsible for the operation of 270 daily routes providing exclusive residential, commercial and roll off services to more than 210,000 residential customers and 16,000 commercial customers under ten municipal contracts.

Coyle has a Bachelor of Science degree in management from De Paul University in Chicago, Illinois. Coyle completed his graduate management courses at California State University in Northridge, California for an M.S. degree in Management.

Coyle is the Past President of the Board of Directors of the Boys and Girls Club of Southern Nevada and a member of the President's Advisory Board of the Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce and a member of the Government Affairs Committee. He is a past member of the Board of Directors of the Nevada Conservation League.
