Professional Biography

Jacob Snow was appointed City Manager for the city of Henderson, Nevada in April 2012. As the city manager, Jacob is responsible for the city's policy direction, strategic planning and oversight of all departments and divisions of the second largest city in the state of Nevada.

Prior to his appointment, Snow served as the general manager of the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada from 1999 to 2012. Under his leadership, the RTC made significant improvements to Southern Nevada's streets and highways, traffic management and public transit system, making travel more convenient, accessible and sustainable for residents and tourists.

He also served as the Assistant Director of Aviation for McCarran International Airport in Clark County, Nevada during which time he received accreditation from the Association of American Airport Executives.

Snow is an active volunteer with the Boy Scouts of America, Las Vegas Area Council, and is currently on the Council's board of directors. He is a former board member of the American Public Transportation Association, Association of Metropolitan Planning Organizations and Western High Speed Rail Alliance.

Jacob was recognized as the Government Official of the Year by the Associated General Contractors and Public Administrator of the Year by the American Society of Public Administrators.
